



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) BETWEEN

GOVERNMENT DEGREE COLLEGE (WOMEN) KUPWARA AND

MUNCIPAL COUNCIL KUPWARA

For

Lifting of Solid Waste from the College & Maintaining its Sanitation/ Cleanliness

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on the 23 Day of Nov. of the year 2021.

BY AND BETWEEN

Muncipal Council Kupwara represented by the Chairman/President (hereinafter referred to as "MCK" which expression shall unless repugnant to the context of meaning thereof, include its successor in office and permitted assigns), on the FIRST PART.

- AND

Government Degree College (Women) Kupwara - 193222 represented by the Principal (hereinafter referred to as "GDCWK" which expression shall unless repugnant to the context of meaning thereof, include its successor in office and permitted assigns) on the SECOND PART.

Whereas MCK and GDCWK have desired to affirm a joint commitment to keep the college campus clean and plastic free.

I. PREAMBLE / BACKGROUND

Municipal or local governance refers to the third tier of governance in India. It was 74th constitutional amendment to the constitution of India in 1992 that brought constitutional validity to municipal or local governments. Among various tasks that the municipality is mandated with includes public health sanitation, conservancy and solid waste management. Kupwara Municipality headed by Municipal Council has been doing its job with great dedication ever since it came into existence.

Government Degree College (Women) Kupwara was established by J&K Higher Education Department in 2011 with an aim to cater to the higher educational needs of girl students of this remote area of the erstwhile state of J&K, now UT. Spread over an area of more than 79 kanals of land the college has an academic block, an administration-cum-library block, 02 toilet blocks and a canteen block. The college has an enrolment of more than 700 students in arts and science streams. It is affiliated to the University of Kashmir and recognized by University Grants Commission under section 2(f) & 12B.

The objective of this MoU is to keep the college campus clean, sanitized, and free of degradable and non-degradable wastes especially single use plastic and other health hazardous items.

II. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- This Memorandum will set up general conditions for cooperation in public health sanitation and solid waste management and that the Parties intend to use as a framework to continue their cooperation.
- The cooperation directions will be defined collectively in the course of negotiations. The parties through mutual effort will try to establish long term and beneficial cooperation.

IIL SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES

Targeting the above goals, the Parties will direct their efforts towards:

 Efficient and regularly monitored cleanliness within the campus by way of collecting and lifting solid wastes, maintaining sanitation of bathrooms, cleanliness of lawns, roads, etc. after proper segregation of waste where ever required.

V. IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MEMORANDUM

In order to ensure the implementation of this Memorandum, the Parties will create a "Waste Management Advisory Committee" (WMAC) which will be responsible for:

- 1. Discussion of the progress of cooperation
- 2. Preparation and coordination of cooperation plans amongst the parties
- 3. Discussion of other issues pertaining to the implementation of this Memorandum.
- 4. Such other matters as may be decided by and between the parties.

VI. ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF GDCWK

 GDCWK will create awareness among students to promote sanitation and cleanliness by all means including NSS, seminars, workshops etc.

VII. ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MCK

- 1. MCK will collect and lift the solid waste from the college in their specified vehicle on alternate days or on any day if the need arises.
- MCK will maintain sanitation of bathrooms through its workers by sweeping, washing, spraying etc. without interfering with college routine affairs.

VIII. DURATION / TERM OF MoU

 This MoU shall be valid for 03 years from the date of its entering into and may be mutually extended from time to time in writing by both the parties.

IX. PROJECT MANAGEMENT TEAM

 GDCWK will appoint a Nodal Officer to facilitate day to day activities. The name and contact details of the same will be shared with MCK immediately after signing of MoU.

X. MONITORING

1. Implementation of MoU will be jointly monitored by GDCWK and MCK.

XI. CHANGES / AMMENDMENT

 No changes/ amendment can be made to this MoU without written consent and duly signed by both the parties.

XII. CONFIDENTIALITY

 Each party undertakes to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from, or supplied to the other party during the period of implementation of the MoU or other agreements made pursuant to this MoU.

XIII. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any difference or dispute between the Parties concerning the interpretation and / implementation
of any of the provisions of this MoU shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and /
or negotiations between the parties without reference to any third party or tribunal.

XIV. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

- The MoU as outlined in this document is not intended to be a legally binding document. Rather, it
 is meant to describe the nature and cooperation intentions of GDCWK and MCK.
- 2. Any other matter not included in this MoU which is necessary for the smooth functioning of the agreement shall be finalized between GDCWK and MCK on mutual terms and conditions.
- 3. The MCK will run all the activities without charging any fee to the GDCWK.

Through this Memorandum of Understanding the GDCWK and MCK affirm their commitment to fulfil and achieve the objectives mutually agreed upon in this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).
