Feedback from students of the institution on syllabus transaction was sought against a total of seven parameters. A total of 60 students forming 8.98 percent of the college roll participated in the process and gave their feedback as follows:

Feedback Analysis:

1. Most of the students (88.3%) are in agreement that the present syllabus is informative and upto the mark.
2. A good number of students believe that the syllabus is value based and addresses the needs of the students.
3. While 68.3% of the respondents were either in "strong agreement" or in "agreement" that the teachers are cooperative and encourage the students, 23.3% respondents remained neutral.

4. 76.6% students are of the opinion that the teachers stimulate the students to think and engage in discussions.
5. Majority of responding students (68.3%) agreed that the teachers are cooperative and encourage them to ask questions.
6. 65% students agreed that the teachers refer to latest developments during their lectures with 20% students showing disagreement.
7. A vast majority of more than 78% students agreed on teachers being self confident with excellent communication skills.

Feedback Analysis:

The feedback received from the teachers reflects that most of the teachers view the syllabus currently taught in the college in a positive direction. The respondents are generally in agreement that the present syllabus is informative and up to the mark. A similar result is observed on the syllabus being value based and addressing the needs of the students. However, on the question of whether the syllabus provides a clear framework and refers to the latest developments, three respondents registered their disagreement, although majority was in agreement. A general agreement was also recorded on syllabus contents being in conformity with the learning outcomes; the learning outcomes meeting the global standards and the curriculum having the potential to develop self learning habit among students. Majority of the participants showed a strong agreement or agreed with curriculum being balanced with regard to theoretical and practical knowledge, while two respondents recorded a strong disagreement.
