Feedback from a total of 75 students was obtained across different semesters on different curricular aspects in the form of a questionnaire. The responses were recorded against five options - Strongly agree, agree, neutral, disagree and strongly disagree and the results are expressed as under:

Analysis:

Upon analyzing the recorded feedback, following inferences can be made.

- 1. Most of the students agree that the syllabus taught in the college caters to the needs of the learners. Only 8 respondents out of 75 recorded their disagreement.
- 2. The respondents generally are satisfied with the effective delivery of the prescribed syllabus.
- 3. An overwhelming majority of respondents gave a positive feedback on regular delivery of classes and completion of syllabus.
- 4. Positive response was recorded on teachers being knowledgeable and the use of latest teaching methods.
- On whether teachers create a cordial and academic friendly environment while lecturing, most of the students gave a positive feedback.

- 6. The teachers take effective measures to improve communication skills of the students. This was strongly agreed by 19 respondents, agreed by 34 responded while 8 respondents showed disagreement. 13 respondents opted to remain neutral.
- 7. 48 respondents showed agreement (30 strongly agreed and 18 agreed) on whether the teachers encourage the students to ask questions and develop critical attitude in them. Only 10 respondents expressed their disagreement.

Feedback Analysis:

- 1. Most of the teachers are in agreement that the present syllabus is as per the need of students and has been presented from simple to complex form.
- 2. A similar result is observed on the syllabus being in conformity with the learning outcomes.
- 3. 9 of the 14 respondents strongly agreed that the curriculum provides opportunity for research activities while 8 respondent teachers agreed that the learning outcome of the syllabus is of global standard.
- 4. Majority of teachers strongly agree that the syllabus is balanced with regard to the theoretical and practical knowledge.
- 5. While 5 respondents agreed that the opinion of the teacher is taken into consideration during curriculum revision, 5 remained silent and 4 respondents disagreed on the issue.
- 6. On whether the syllabus contents are value oriented or not, 10 out of 14 participants responded in affirmation whereas 4 remained neutral.
