Seminar Report on Drug Menace in Kashmir

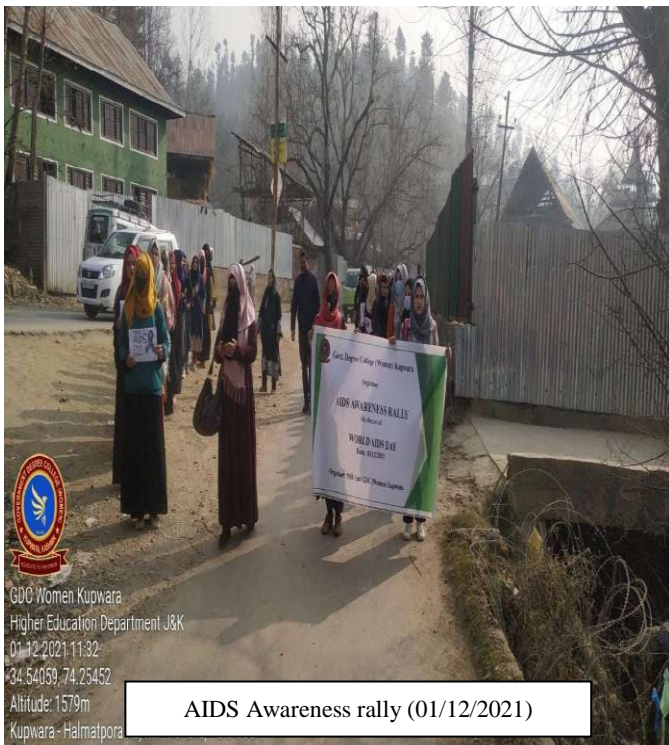
